Scoring

Answers are scored from 0 (never) to 5 (always) for all items except n° 10 and 12 that have a reverse score from 5 (never) to 0 (always). General SOCQ covers all items, and is made up of 4 subscales: ‘family’ (items n° 1 to 4), ‘friends’ (items n° 5 to 8), ‘acquaintances’ (items n° 9 to 12), and ‘work/study colleagues’ (items n° 13 to 16).
